Issue #	Description
1	TPEG: Data inconsistency (No "slip road" attribute).
2	TRAFFIC: Geospatial filter is not applied in flowavailability requests.
3	TPEG: server sends precise information for short tmcs not according to the standard.
4	TPEG: Get Messages by Table ID does not return newly created TFP messages.
5	NullPointerException in TrafficRenderer when sub segments are removed during rendering.
6	TPEG: Delta does not detect appearing of sub-segments.
