### **Added Functionality**

- Waypoints Sequence Extension API allows you to specify time periods for driving times and rest times
  - A long and a short period can be provided. In this context it also can be specified, if the time spent at a waypoint can be used for resting.
- The limit for the number waypoints has been extended to 100, if the traffic option is disabled. If the traffic option is enabled the limit for the number of waypoints is 50 (unchanged).

Issue ID	Description
1	Parameter end was treated as required although the documentation stated it was optional.
2	Spelling of weekday abbreviations in error messages has been corrected.
3	An issue causing an internal server error, if a certain number of waypoints has been exceeded has been fixed. This number of waypoints was dependent from the actual request.
