#	Description
1	Prohibit creation of queries on expired datasets.
2	Implement background job to notify users about datasets that are about to expire.
3	API endpoint providing a list of available layers.

#	Issue
1	Creating or updating a query that is defined on an expired dataset should fail with an http 400.
2	Remove ability for any user to request jobs by an ID.

#	Issue
1	After updating a query and hard reloading provider, old points are still appearing
2	Antennae example drop-down menu opens unexpectedly
