/v3/board	max	The default number of results is 40 and the maximum is set to 500.
/v3/multiboard/by_geocoord	max	The maximum number of results is now set to 100.
/v3/multiboard/by_geocoord	maxStn	The maximum number of stations is now set to 40 (same as the Default value).
/v3/multiboard/by_stn_ids	max	The maximum number of results is now set to 100.
/v3/stations/by_geocoord	max	The maximum number of results is now set to 50.
/v3/stations/by_name	max	The maximum number of results is now set to 25.
